A total of nine public schools in Arkansas were named Exemplary schools today under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act program.

Exemplary schools are Achieving schools that have demonstrated high performance or high progress for all students and a subgroup of students consisting of high poverty students, students with disabilities, and students with limited English proficiency. These schools must also meet their Annual Measurable Objectives for all ESEA subgroups.
