# HARDING UNIVERSITY'S ADULT AND EXTENDED EDUCATION PROGRAM Degree Completion Program in Education

## *What is the Degree Completion Program in Education?*

Whether you have finished your Associate of Arts degree or have at least 60 hours of undergraduate course work, you are now ready to take classes to become a licensed teacher.

Harding University invites you to enroll in our Degree Completion Program in Education to obtain your Arkansas teaching license. The program leads to a Bachelor of Arts degree in the following areas:

- Birth through kindergarten integrated with special education birth through kindergarten
- Elementary K-6
- Middle Level 4-8 in any two of the following areas:
  - English/Language Arts
  - Math
  - Science
  - Social Science

## *What are the admission requirements?*

To be admitted, you must be at least 23 years old and have completed 60 or more hours of college credit.

Admission process:

- Complete application with application fee
- Provide one academic reference
- Submit all official transcripts
- Submit your immunization records

## *What are the program requirements?*

Throughout the program, you will be required to:

- Complete eight credit hours of Bible
- Participate in several field experience activities
- Complete a minimum of 128 hours (inclusive of transfer hours) to be able to graduate

## *When are classes offered?*

With flexible scheduling, most classes will be offered at six-week intervals in the evenings and on weekends in an attempt to accommodate nontraditional students. Some classes are also offered online for further convenience.
