



Internet Safety Resources

Protecting Children in the 21st Century Act of 2011 changed the CIPA (Children's Internet Protection Act) and mandated Schools and libraries subject to CIPA may not receive the discounts offered by the E-rate program unless they certify that they have an Internet safety policy that includes technology protection measures. The protection measures must block or filter Internet access to pictures that are: (a) obscene; (b) child pornography; or (c) harmful to minors (for computers that are accessed by minors). Before adopting this Internet safety policy, schools and libraries must provide reasonable notice and hold at least one public.

The new CIPA mandate requires schools to provide for the education of minors, (anyone under 17 years of age).
