NAEP is an integral part of education in the United States.

- Elected officials, policymakers, and educators all use NAEP results to develop ways to improve education.
- NAEP provides a common measure of student achievement across the country.
- NAEP **does not** produce scores for individual students or results for schools; participation in NAEP is not tied to grades or evaluations of students, teachers, or schools.
- NAEP-TIMSS linking study places AR on an international ranking ([2011 results](#)). 2015 results TBA.
- NAEP mapping study allows a comparison of NAEP results with state assessments ([2017](#), [2015](#), [2013 results](#)).

The National Assessment of Education Progress ([NAEP](#)) is given each spring to a [sampling](#) of U.S. students. NAEP [questions](#) and [schedule](#) are created under the guidance of the [National Assessment Governing Board \(NAGB\)](#).

For AR, NAEP 2020 will test mathematics and reading. Resources for testing [districts](#) and [principals](#).

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NAEP is given each spring with a schedule determined by National Assessment Governing Board (NAGB). NAEP questions are created under the guidance of the NAGB. The assessment schedule provides the most recent NAEP tests that have/will be given.
