Re: *Hot Springs School District Claim of Conflict with the Public School Choice Act of 2015, Ark. Code Ann. § 6-18-1901 et seq.*

Dear Superintendent Nehus:

The Arkansas Department of Education, Division of Elementary and Secondary Education, has reviewed the documentation submitted by the Hot Springs School District in support of the District's claim that provisions of an enforceable desegregation court order or a court-approved desegregation plan bars the District from participating in school choice under the Public School Choice Act of 2015. Specifically, the District provided documents concerning a lawsuit filed in the United States District Court for the Western District of Arkansas captioned *Davis, et al., v. Hot Springs School District, et al.*, Case No. 89-6088.

Based on the documentation provided, the Division has determined that the Hot Springs School District is not required to participate in school choice under the Act, as participation would conflict with the terms of a federal court order.
