YOUR EMAIL ACCOUNT IS BEING TARGETED!

EMAIL HEADERS

You should never trust messages sent from a strange sender. Be sure to verify the actual email address.

EMAIL BODY

Pay attention to unusual typos and general greetings. You should always be suspicious of embedded links.

EMAIL ATTACHMENTS

Be suspicious of all attachments, even from people you know!
