- 2) Teachers are selling snacks to students during the school day. The required documentation was not available to confirm compliance with Smart Snack regulations.
- 3) Opened bags of food items in the refrigerator were observed to have no date.
- 4) Upon observation of the afterschool snack program, crates of juice were placed directly onto the floor- Arkansas State Board of Health Food Code 3-501.11.
