That one household was determined free and should have been reduced based on income. 2) A review of the 2018-2019 verification file indicated verification errors. According to the Eligibility Manual for School Meals, to establish income eligibility for a household, determining officials must compare the household size and the total household gross income. The verification process includes a confirmation of the income eligibility submitted by the household. There were two (2) applications out of seven (7) that were verified incorrectly because net income was used instead of gross. One was verified as free but should be reduced and the other was verified as reduced but should be paid. B.
