Findings:

 the required On-Site Review Form was not completed as well as other various questions
 throughout the form. The form was completed at the time of the review.
- 2. In accordance with 2 CFR 200.430, charges to federal awards for salaries and wages must be based on records that accurately reflect the work performed. Time Certification documentation is not being retained for any Child Nutrition employees.
- 3. All schools must adhere to food and safety standards in the Arkansas State Board of Health Food
 - 3-501.17 Ready-to-Eat, Potentially Hazardous Food, (Time/Temperature Control for Safety Food) Date Marking. At the time of the review, the milk cooler was observed to have newer dated milk on top of older dated milk.
 - When received, all foods should be dated to ensure proper use and safety of food supply (FIFO first in first out inventory procedures). Also, Temperature logs for the dry storage are not being kept.
- 4. In accordance with 7 CFR 210.12(d)(2) SFAs must cooperate with Summer Food Service Program sponsors to distribute materials to inform families of the availability and location of free Summer Food Service Program meals for students when school is not in session .Documentation of Summer Feeding Outreach was not available at the time of review.
