In order for applications to be considered complete, all information must be filled out and meal status must be determined correctly. 2) A review of the 2018-2019 verification file indicated verification errors. There were six (6) applications that had verification errors. When completing verification, for every income frequencies checked on the application, a source of information must be received. Of the six (6) applications, five (5) did not contain sufficient pay information documentation. 3) Reviewing and comparing the school district's October claim to the daily records from October, showed that sixty (60) free meal status students were not counted on the claim. Also, the preschool student count were not added to the claim. The claim must be revised and sent to Sheila Chastain to re-enter the correct amounts. B.
