Meal Access and Reimbursement - Performance Standard 1 YES Technical Assistance NO Corrective Action Certification and Benefit Issuance Verification Meal Counting and Claiming П Charge Policy and Unpaid Meal Procedures П Findings: 1) Of the 380 student eligibility source documents reviewed the following issues were observed: Two applications did not have the determination date as determined by the determining official, Two applications did not have the last four digits of an adult household member's social security number, or the boxed checked that they did not have one. One application noted a parent called with a change in income, there was no date or initials next to the changes written on the application. The income change qualified the household for free eligible meals, but the students were listed as reduced on the child nutrition master roster. One application was initially determined to be denied, but after an income clarification from the household they were determined to be reduced eligible. The application was not updated to show reduced edibility determination, but were listed correctly on the child nutrition master roster. 2) A review of the 2018-2019 verification file indicated verification errors: The district's confirming official did not sign and date the verification tracker form as required in 7 CFR 245.6a(i)(1)(e). In the yearly Policy Statement and Agreement with the Arkansas Department of Education, Child Nutrition Unit (ADE, CNU) the district stated that it was using the state approved letters for verification. It was observed the district was instead using letters from their software program, which did not contain all required elements. The verification letters sent households did not have the full USDA non-discrimination statement in its entirety. The verification letters sent to households did not contain the required "Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act" statement. The verification letters sent to households asked for the full social security numbers of all adults in the household. Only the last 4 digits are needed for one adult within the household. One application was verified by a picture of a bank statement sent in by the household. According the Eligibility Manual for School Meals this is not an accepted form of income verification. B.
