In order for applications to be considered complete, all information must be filled out. At the time of the review, the Child Nutrition Department tried to obtain the parent signature however the parent refused to sign the application. Documentation of this scenario was kept on file and the application was marked incomplete and a letter was sent to the household stating the student's meal status will be changed to paid in 10 days. No further action is required. 2) Categorically eligible lists (migrant, homeless, foster children, Head Start, Even Start) must be signed and dated by the appropriate liaison as changes are made, however at the time of the review the migrant list was not signed and dated. The migrant list was sent back to the liaison to be signed and dated. No further action is required. B. Meal Patterns and Nutritional Quality YES Technical Assistance Corrective Action NO Meal Components and Quantities Offer versus Serve Dietary Specifications and Nutrient Analysis Findings: 1) On the days of observation at Glenview, preschool students received a different serving size of vegetables than the production record documented. A visit with the site manager revealed that smaller serving utensils are used for pre-k due to the preschool meal service times being separate than kindergarten-fifth grade. Preschool production records were not accurately completed in accordance with 7 CFR 210.10 (a)(3) Production and menu records. Schools or school food authorities, as applicable, must keep production and menu records for the meals they produce. These records must show how the meals offered contribute to the required food components and food quantities for each age/grade group every day. C. Findings:

- North Little Rock School District menus contained the wrong non-discrimination statement. The Child Nutrition
 Director contacted the menu software company to have corrected at the time of the review. No further action
 required.
- 2) North Little Rock School District's website contained the wrong non-discrimination statement. The Child Nutrition Director corrected at the time of the review. No further action required.
- 3) North Little Rock High School and the Center of Excellence do not have any special event days entered into the eSchool Calendar.
- 4) When observing Glenview elementary lunch service, a table of students with Chick-fil-a was witnessed. This table was labeled "Terrific Kids". We learned that every 9 weeks the teachers choose a terrific kid from their classroom. While this is a wonderful program, if foods are provided or sold to students during the school day it must meet the Smart Snack Calculator requirements or be one of the schools 9 special event days. October 30, 2018 was not listed as one of Glenview's 9 special event days located in the eSchool calendar.
- 5) Thermometer calibration records were observed during the time of the review, however all thermometers located in the cafeterias are not being calibrated.
