Re: Letter of Intent to Apply for an Open Enrollment Public Charter School

To Whom It May Concern:

It is the intention of Responsive Education Solutions ("ResponsiveEd") to apply for an open-enrollment public charter school in North Little Rock, Arkansas, to be located within the boundaries of the North Little Rock School District, and to be referred to as Premier High School of North Little Rock. ResponsiveEd operates over 70 openenrollment public charter schools in Arkansas and Texas, with an enrollment of over 19,000 current students. The mission of ResponsiveEd is to provide hope for students through an innovative, encouraging, character-based, personalized learning environment where they are academically successful and develop into lifelong learners. ResponsiveEd has been authorized by the Arkansas Secretary of State to transact business in the State of Arkansas as a Non-Profit Corporation and has received recognition of exemption under the Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The proposed campus anticipates serving grades 9 - 12 with a maximum enrollment of 150 students in the first year of operation. Maximum enrollment will be no more than 225 students when the campus is at full capacity. Premier High School of North Little Rock will use a blended learning model that incorporates individualized instruction, learning modules and a proven instructional delivery system that will allow students to move at a pace that will guarantee success. The campus will focus on credit recovery, drop-out prevention and accelerated instruction, with the end goal being high school graduation. The model strives to equip all students with the tools necessary for success in later years.
