IN RE JULIE GROSS AULTMAN; FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSION OF LAW, AND ORDER

At its meeting on April 13, 2017, the Arkansas State Board of Education ("Board") considered the matter of the revocation of Julie Gross Aultman's ("Educator Aultman") license. Upon the evidence presented and the Educator Aultman's consent to permanently revoke her license, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-101 et seq., the Board hereby states as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

- Educator Aultman's standard five-year license was valid until December 31, 2016, and by this surrender may not be renewed.
- 2. Educator Aultman has voluntarily surrendered her license with the understanding that the law does not have a provision for the mere surrender of a license and that, therefore, the surrender of a license will result in its permanent revocation.
- 3. Educator Aultman has waived any right to notice or a hearing or any other rights she might be entitled to under the Administrative Procedure Act including those rights set forth in Ark. Code Ann. §§ 25-15-211 and 212.
- 4. Educator Aultman's surrender is evidenced by her signed consent attached to this order.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Administrative Procedure Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-208 (b), provides for the resolution of this matter by consent order.

- 2. The Board voted unanimously to accept the surrender of Educator Aultman's license.
- 3. Educator Aultman's Arkansas teaching license is hereby permanently revoked.
- 4. This order shall remain permanently in Educator Aultman's professional licensure file and the confidential files of the Professional Licensure Standards Board.

 no provision for the mere surrender of an educator's license.
- I acknowledge and understand that the Department of Education reports revocation of an educator's license to the NASDTEC Clearinghouse, which is a national database consulted by other states' licensure units.
- 8. I waive all rights I may have to any further notice, hearing, or appeal under the Arkansas Administrative Procedures Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-101 et seq.
