BEFORE THE ARKANSAS STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION APRIL 13, 2017

IN RE LEE MICAL SADLER FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSION OF LAW, AND ORDER

At its meeting on April 13, 2017, the Arkansas State Board of Education ("Board") considered the matter of the revocation of Lee Mical Sadler's ("Educator Sadler") license. Upon the evidence presented and Educator Sadler's consent to permanently revoke his license, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-101 et seq., the Board hereby states as follows:

I. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Educator Sadler's standard five-year license was valid until December 31, 2019.
- 2. Educator Sadler has voluntarily surrendered his license with the understanding that the law does not have a provision for the mere surrender of a license and that, therefore, the surrender of a license will result in its permanent revocation.
- 3. Educator Sadler has waived any right to notice or a hearing or any other rights he might be entitled to under the Administrative Procedure Act including those rights set forth in Ark. Code Ann. §§ 25-15-211 and 212.
- 4. Educator Sadler's surrender is evidenced by the signed consent attached to this order.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Administrative Procedure Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-208 (b), provides for the resolution of this matter by consent order.
- 2. The Board voted unanimously to accept the surrender of Educator Sadler's license.
- 3. Educator Sadler's Arkansas teaching license is hereby permanently revoked. This order



- I, Lee Sadler, voluntarily surrender my Arkansas educator's license and any right to apply for renewal.
- 2. I understand that an educator's license means a teaching license and/or administrator's license.
- 3. I acknowledge and understand that I <u>cannot</u> apply for an educator's license in Arkansas <u>at any time</u> in the future.
- 4. I shall not apply for an educator's license at any time in the future.
- 5. Lacknowledge and understand that an educator's license shall not be issued to me at any time in the future.
- I acknowledge and understand that the State Board of Education's acceptance of the surrender of my educator's license will result in its <u>PERMANENT</u> <u>REVOCATION</u> because Arkansas law has no provision for the mere surrender of an educator's license.
- 7. I acknowledge and understand that the Department of Education reports revocation of an educator's license to the NASDTEC Clearinghouse, which is a national database consulted by other states' licensure units.
- 8. I waive all rights I may have to any further notice, hearing, or appeal under the Arkansas Administrative Procedures Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-101 et seq.
- 9. I am___/I am not__k_ represented by legal counsel in this matter.
