**IN RE TYLER CAMERON PICKETT  
CONSENT ORDER FOR SURRENDER AND REVOCATION OF LICENSE**

The Arkansas State Board of Education (“Board”), in the matter of the surrender and revocation of the license of Tyler Cameron Pickett (“Educator Pickett”), find that the voluntary surrender of his license should be acknowledged and his license should be permanently revoked in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, Ark. Code Ann. 25-15-101 et seq.

Accordingly the Board hereby states:

**I. FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Educator Pickett has a renewable license valid until December 31, 2019.
2. Educator Pickett has voluntarily surrendered his license with the understanding that the Board does not have a provision for the mere surrender of a license and that, therefore, the surrender of Educator Pickett’s license will result in its permanent revocation.
3. Educator Pickett has waived any right to notice or hearing or any other rights he might be entitled to under the Administrative Procedure Act including those rights set forth in Ark. Code Ann. §§ 25-15-211 and 212.
4. Educator Pickett’s surrender is evidenced by the signed consent attached to this order.


**II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Administrative Procedure Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-208(b), provided for the resolution of this matter by consent order.

2. The Board voted unanimously to accept the surrender of Educator Pickett's license.
3. Educator Pickett's Arkansas teaching license is hereby permanently revoked.
4. This order shall become a permanent entry in the licensure file of Educator Pickett.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

CONSENT TO THE PERMANENT REVOCATION OF MY ARKANSAS EDUCATOR'S LICENSE

1. I, **Tyler Pickett**, voluntarily surrender my Arkansas educator's license and any right to apply for renewal.
2. I understand that an educator's license means a teaching license and/or an administrator's license.
3. I acknowledge and understand that I **cannot** apply for an educator's license in Arkansas **at any time** in the future.
4. I **shall not** apply for an educator's license in Arkansas **at any time** in the future.
5. I acknowledge and understand that an educator's license **shall not** be issued to me at any time in the future.
6. I acknowledge and understand that the State Board of Education's acceptance of the surrender of my educator's license will result in its **PERMANENT REVOCATION** because Arkansas law has no provision for the mere surrender of an educator's license.
7. I acknowledge and understand that the Department of Education reports revocation of an educator's license to the NASDTEC Clearinghouse, which is a national database consulted by other states' licensure units.
8. I waive all rights I may have to any further notice, hearing, or appeal under the Arkansas Administrative Procedures Act, Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-101 et seq.
