CHARTER SCHOOL OFFICE

The application for charter is submitted by Jonesboro High School. The charter school would be Jonesboro STEM Academy and would be located within Jonesboro High School at 301 Hurricane Drive, Jonesboro, AR. Students in grades 10 – 12 would be served at the school. The proposed enrollment cap would be no matter than 1200 students.
