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LEA and Data Crosswalk for 2018-2019 School Year

Introduction

The LEA and data crosswalk for the 2018-2019 is based on requests for LEA changes provided by Research and Technology, the school information provided by school districts, and Division of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) leadership approval. From these sources schools are divided into six categories based on how the LEA numbers and data may need to be crosswalked from prior LEA number to new LEA number or not crosswalked at all. Crosswalking data ensures that historical performance data from a school follows the school when the school changes grade band, changes an LEA number, is annexed by another school, or is combined with another school from one year to the next year. The following considerations will be utilized for accountability and reporting:

- New Schools
- Closed Schools
- Existing Schools with grade configuration changes only
- Existing Schools with new LEA Numbers
- Annexed Schools
- Combined Schools with new LEA Numbers

At the end of this document, feeder schools and Alternative Learning Environment (ALE) schools are listed.

- Feeder schools are schools with grade configurations that do not include a tested grade yet need to be included in the accountability system. To include these schools in the accountability system these feeder schools are paired with an elementary school or schools that receive the students from the feeder school.
- According to accountability rules, ALE schools, or schools whose mission and enrollment are primarily focused on students who have dropped out of high school or are identified as at risk of dropping out of high school are exempt from receiving a school rating, or letter grade. To ensure districts are held accountable for the performance of the students attending these ALE's, the students are reassigned to the traditional school they would have otherwise attended and count towards the school rating of that school.

New Schools

Description: New schools are not crosswalked with prior LEA numbers or to any prior data. These schools receive their first accountability reports at the end of the year that they are considered a new school. Only one year of data will be available for use for new schools. These new schools fall into three different categories: new school in a new district, new school in an existing district, and new school resulting from a grade reconfiguration in an existing district. New schools in new districts result from the creation of a new school district, most commonly this happens from the opening of a new charter school or from a new district being created through detachment. A new school in an existing district is usually the result of a school being added due to enrollment increases or the district opening a new school to meet a new need in a district (ALE, virtual, magnet, etc.). A new school resulting from a grade reconfiguration in an existing district usually happens when a district reorganizes the way in which grades are assigned to buildings and the new configuration results in students that were previously in one building being dispersed amongst several buildings or the opposite, students that were previously in several different buildings being consolidated into two or more different buildings.

Closed Schools

Description: Schools that fall into this category are schools that close and result in students being dispersed into two or more existing schools.

Existing Schools with grade configuration changes only (no LEA number change)

Description: Schools in this category have changed the grade configurations within their existing campuses and corresponding LEA numbers. These changes in grades within the LEA may cause a change in grade band. For example, a school that adds grades to an existing school could go from a K-6 to a K-8, causing the school to move from grade band 1-elementary level to grade band 2-middle level while maintaining the same LEA number. So while being in this category does not necessitate a crosswalk, the note in grade band change is significant due to the school switching from one group of comparison schools to another.

Existing Schools with new LEA Numbers

Description: Schools in this category close by changing LEA numbers and open the same school under a new LEA number or through reconfiguration of existing student populations served (i.e., changes to grade ranges served). In some cases school LEA numbers change to align to the district with which the school is consolidating. In other cases, a district makes a system-wide change to the grade levels served within the buildings and new LEA numbers are requested to accompany the changes. The historical data (prior two years) from the closing school is crosswalked to the new LEA number/school that serves the substantively similar or same student population. These schools will receive accountability reports for 2019 that have current year data based on the new LEA number student population and prior year data based on the crosswalked closed LEA number student population since these schools are serving substantively similar population of students as compared to prior years.

Annexed Schools (combined under existing LEA numbers)

Description: Schools in this category have two schools combining into one existing school—one LEA number closes, the other LEA number continues. When this happens, one school is annexed by an existing (continuing) school, the historical data of the annexed (closed) school is crosswalked with the continuing school/LEA number.

Combined Schools with new LEA Numbers

Description: In the case where two schools are combined under a new LEA number and the two previous LEA numbers are inactivated for the closed schools, historic data from prior two years are combined from the two closing LEAs to constitute the two prior years of data for the new LEA number. This procedure allows the historic data from students served under the closed LEA numbers to be combined and inform three years of accountability data for the new LEA number, which serves substantively similar students as the two closed LEA numbers.

2018-2019 Feeder Schools with Paired School

Schools with grade configurations that do not include a tested grade must be included in the accountability system. Most commonly these schools are primary schools that feed into an elementary or intermediate school. To include these schools in the accountability system these feeder schools are paired with an elementary school or schools that receive the students from the feeder school.

In the case of feeder schools, the achievement and growth of the paired school are used to provide an achievement and growth score for the feeder school. The achievement and growth score from the paired school are combined with the School Quality and Student Success Score for the feeder school. Since the feeder school does not have a tested grade, the School Quality and Student Success Score includes only one component—the Student Engagement component.

Schools Exempt from Ratings (Letter Grades)

According to the Arkansas Department of Education Rules Governing The Public School Rating System on Annual Performance Reports and The School Recognition Program, the following entities shall be exempt from the designation of a school rating:

- An open-enrollment public charter school whose mission and enrollment are primarily focused on students who have dropped out of high school or are identified as at risk of dropping out of school;
- A conversion public charter school whose mission and enrollment are primarily focused on students who have dropped out of high school or are identified as at risk of dropping out of school;
- An adult charter school serving students age 19 or older;
- The Arkansas School for the Blind;
- The Arkansas School for the Deaf; and
- The Division of Youth Services System of Education.
