### **Data Security**

- The Arkansas Department of Education has an inherent responsibility to not only safeguard student data but also to equip stakeholders with the information needed to ensure data privacy. The ADE ensures all data is used in compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), ensuring only those with a legitimate educational interest have access to data.
- Arkansas has taken additional steps to safeguard student data. A new data privacy law was passed: The Student Online Personal Information Act (SOPIA) –

The new law governs how online service providers can collect, access, and use student data and prohibits online service providers from using student data for commercial or secondary purposes, while still allowing for personalized learning and service innovation and improvement.
- In addition, the IT Security Policy was updated in order to stay on the forefront of data privacy and security. The IT Security Policy requires districts to plan, document, deploy, and monitor IT security mechanisms, policies, procedures, and technologies necessary to prevent disclosure, modification or denial of sensitive information.
