

Student Success Plan Guidance for Homeschool Students

In Arkansas Public Schools, starting in the 8th grade every child will have a Student Success Plan. This plan is designed to help a child complete their secondary education track prepared for the next phase, be it employment, higher education, or civic engagement.

- Act 930 of 2017 defines a Student Success Plan as “a personalized education plan intended to assist students with achieving readiness for college, career, and community engagement.”
- Act 456 of 2019 created the Arkansas Concurrent Challenge. Home school students are eligible to apply for the scholarship, but must have a Student Success Plan in place.
 - The Student Success Plan for a student who is enrolled in an endorsed concurrent enrollment course or certificate program shall be prepared in consultation with:
 - School personnel, the student, and the student's parent or legal guardian; or a college advisor

Homeschool parents and students who wish to apply for the Arkansas Concurrent Challenge Scholarship may create their own Student Success Plan by jointly working with the higher education institution or local school (if the student takes courses at the local district).

There are 4 components to a Student Success Plan, and each is specific for a student based on their life goals, academic performance, and abilities. An active plan should be reviewed regularly with your student and updated annually. Each section below guides you through the process of developing a plan for your child.

- 1. Pathway to Graduation:** this section should include a plan for coursework and documentation of completed learning. This could come from student portfolios or independent assessment tools or as part of a curriculum program. Homeschool parents may collaborate with a college advisor or school personnel to plan accordingly.

- 2. Accelerated Learning Opportunities:** this section should include ways in which areas of aptitude or interest can be identified for a student and deeper instruction or advanced learning opportunities are provided. This may be based on coursework, test scores, desired knowledge or interest.

- 3. Academic Deficits or Interventions:** this section should include ways in which areas in need of improvement can be identified for a student and alternate learning methods or additional supports are provided. This may be based on coursework, test scores, or desired levels of performance not currently being met.

- 4. Career Planning:** this section should include opportunities for a student to explore various career options and gain experience in a potential career path. This may include structured training and coursework or entrepreneurial experience or internships.
