



District Assurance for Credit by Demonstrated Mastery

Students shall earn credit for a high school course by demonstrating a deep understanding of the content without standard course enrollment or seat time. Weighted credit shall not be available for credit by demonstrated mastery.

The process shall be open to all students, and shall be applied on an individual basis rather than to groups of students as a whole. It is not intended to replace the general accelerated pathways local school districts often provide for advanced students.

Students shall demonstrate mastery through a multi-phase assessment process. If students are unable to meet the established minimum score in Phase I, they will not be allowed to progress to Phase II.

Student applications and artifacts shall be reviewed by a local panel and held to the guidelines for each Phase and type of course.

The District shall adhere to the approved plan until such time as changes are necessary. Before changes are implemented, a new complete application will be submitted and approved.

Renewal of an existing, unchanged, approved plan will be done every 5 years by resubmission of these District Assurances for Demonstrated Mastery.
