Dear Cheryl, Daryl, and Karmesha:

I represent Phyllis D. Brooks. For your reference, enclosed is a copy of a notice concerning background check dated September 28, 2017, from Karmesha Smith, Administrative Analyst, Office of Professional Educators.

It is my understanding that Ms. Brooks has had an Arkansas teaching license since approximately 1995, so this is yet one more instance of a decades old true finding popping up for the first time after an educator has had their license issued and renewed any number of times in the interim.

Ms. Smith's notice to Ms. Brooks reads as if she is being denied eligibility for licensure when, in fact, I respectfully submit to you that this would be a situation where the Department would be informing her that they are required by law to revoke her license, but also informing her at the same time that she has the right to request a waiver.

The Arkansas Department of Education has reviewed your background checks required under Ark. Code Ann. § 6-17-410 and § 6-17-411 as a condition of your licensure or employment with a charter school, school district, or education service cooperative.

Specifically, our office has received a finding of a true report against you from the Child Maltreatment Central Registry.

Therefore, the Department will recommend that the State Board of Education deny your eligibility for licensure and employment in an Arkansas public school or education service cooperative.

Seeking Name Removal from the Department of Human Services:

The Department of Human Services has advised us that it also sent you a letter concerning the true report. You must contact this office within fourteen (14) days of the date of this letter if you intend to seek to have your name removed from the Child Maltreatment Central Registry. If you are successful in getting your name removed from the Child Maltreatment Registry, our office may be able to withdraw this letter. (See the information below for contacting the Department of Human Services).

Failure to contact us or provide this information within fourteen (14) days of the date of this letter may result in denial of your licensure and disqualify you for employment in a charter school, school district, or education service cooperative.

REQUESTING A WAIVER OF A DISQUALIFYING OFFENSE

You have been notified that, as a result of the background check reviewed by the Arkansas Department of Education, you are disqualified for licensure and for employment with a charter school, school district, or education service cooperative, and that you are entitled to request a waiver of that disqualification from the State Board of Education. Below are the steps to follow to seek a waiver.

Ark. Code Ann. § 6-17-410

provides that the Department of Education shall not issue a first-time license nor renew an existing license and shall revoke any existing license not up for renewal of any person who has a true report in the Child Maltreatment Central Registry or has pled guilty or nolo contendere to or has been found guilty of any of [certain listed] offenses, including offenses which have been expunged or pardoned.

Ark. Code Ann. § 6-17-411

requires a background check for initial employment with a charter school, school district. or education service cooperative.

1 Request a Hearing

To request a hearing for a waiver of the disqualifying offense, you must submit your <u>written</u> request to the Department by mail, fax, or email, <u>within thirty (30) days</u> of the date you are notified of the disqualification.

You may but are not required to be represented by an attorney at any stage of this process.

2 Provide Documentation

The Department will confirm your request for a waiver and ask you to provide a written statement and any supporting documents that at a minimum address the circumstances that the Board will consider (see STEP 3), including the names and phone numbers of persons who may verify information contained in your statement or documentation. You must also provide a signed and notarized form providing authorization for the release of criminal records from courts and law enforcement. If your documentation is received less than six (6) weeks before the scheduled State Board meeting the matter will be postponed until after all documentation is received and reviewed by the Department.

3 Accept or Reject the Department's Recommendation

After reviewing the documentation received from you or from other agencies, the Department will advise you of its decision to:

- Recommend a waiver to the State Board, including any conditions for licensure, such as:
 - o Probation or suspension for a specific period of time;
 - o Counseling, rehabilitation, or training;
 - o Background check at end of probation or suspension;
 - No other disqualifying offenses or ethics violations during the probation or suspension period;
- Recommend that the State Board not issue, not renew, or revoke the license as applicable;
 or
- Decline to make a recommendation.

You will be given the opportunity to accept or reject the recommendation.

- If you <u>accept</u> the recommendation, the matter will be placed on the State Board's consent agenda. The consent agenda is voted on at that public meeting, and therefore, any documents presented to the State Board are public. If the matter is submitted on the consent agenda, you do not have to appear at the meeting. However, sometimes the State Board members have questions, and you may want to be there to respond to those questions. The State Board has the final decision and may accept a recommendation on the consent agenda or reject the recommendation and afford the educator the opportunity for a hearing at a later date.
- If you reject the recommendation you will proceed to a hearing.

4 State Board Hearing

If you request a hearing, you should appear at the meeting and be prepared to present your case and answer questions from the State Board members. If you request a hearing and do not appear, the State Board may decide the matter without you being present. Hearings are conducted at a public meeting of the State Board that is videoed by live streaming and archived. All documents provided to the State Board are public record. You should consult the Rules Governing Background Checks for information on the hearing process (Section 8). The rules are online at http://www.arkansased.org/ under Rules – Current.

The circumstances that the State Board may consider includes, but is not limited to:

- The age at which the crime or incident was committed
- The circumstances surrounding the crime or incident
- The length of time since the crime or incident
- Subsequent work history
- Employment references
- Character references
- Other evidence demonstrating that the applicant does not pose a threat to the health or safety of school children or school personnel.

The State Board typically makes a decision at the time of the State Board meeting at which the consent agenda or hearing is considered.

For your reference and recollection, enclosed is a copy of Request for Name Removal from the Central Registry, which was submitted to your office by Phyllis D. Jennings, now known as Phyllis D. Brooks, with a copy of her transmittal letter dated 10/11/2017.

Enclosed herewith you will find the necessary items which were not included with her original request for name removal submitted to your office:

- Registry check and summary report dated 09/07/2017 from John Lowden, Manager, Child Maltreatment Central Registry.
 - Arkansas Criminal History Report dated 10/16/2017.
- Narrative from Ms. Brooks which sets forth her recollection of the event which apparently led to the true finding for inadequate supervision (of which she was never aware until she recently applied to renew her Arkansas Department of Education teaching license). Having never known of the true finding, she did not specifically participate in a treatment or rehabilitation program; however, she explains that she continued to work with DCFS long after this event. Further, she has now had her Arkansas teaching license for approximately 20 years and, as you are no doubt aware, must complete substantial hours of professional development every year, a great number of which deal with child maltreatment issues.

I will tell you that Ms. Brooks and I are scheduled to appear before the State Board of Education on December 14, 2017, to request that she be granted a waiver of revocation of her teaching license based on the fact that it is just now coming to everyone's attention that she has evidently been on the Child Maltreatment Registry since 1993 (this is not the first instance of an old true finding, of which an alleged offender was never aware, coming to light some 20-25 years later). Based on my experience with the Department of Education, I have no doubt that they will grant her a waiver of this disqualifying event, given the circumstances and the length of time since the alleged occurrence.


I was a Social Service Aide I for the Department of Human Services-Division of Children and Family Services. What our job description is aide to the families by providing supervision in parenting, transportation to meet the physical, social, medical, and intellectual needs of the child. However, we also supervise the parents in homemaking skills, such as cooking, cleaning, shopping, and etc. We also attend court as a key witness to the parent meeting the needs of the court ordered documents. We as SSAI make frequent home visits to assist in any way of keeping the child in a safe environment. We also assist in court ordered parenting classes. Which is ordered by the court as a part of the fulfillment of maintaining a safe environment for the children. If there are any problems in the home such as gas leaks, hot water heater no longer working, rent needs to be paid, DCFS assist in managing everyday living to keep the parent and children in their home. We travel wherever need be to provide social, educational, physical, medical, adequate service for the children. The parent is also responsible for rehabilitation suck as counseling, AAA, drug rehabilitation, anything that provides growth in the area of child maltreatment, we support but they are responsible for attending the meeting. Our office stays involved providing details narratives of what we have done with the parent and children. We report anything that is a hinderance to the growth of the family.

On October 27, 1993

I went to families' home to transport child, however upon taking her to the hair salon appointment, I was expecting a check to be left at the front desk of my office. I secured her in car seat, I had child proof safety locks on my doors, the back windows were rolled down at child proof. I parked in front of the DHS-DCFS building and ran inside to get the check. You can view the car and child from the front entrance of the receptionist desk. The receptionist stated no one left a check for you ask the caseworker, I proceeded in asking the casework, she sat down to write out the check. I immediately told her I have to go to the car and get the child. She then left the desk and we both ran to the car. She was fine just as I left her for approximately 3-4 minutes. My intentions was not to do any harm to the child, in addition I was suspended with no pay for two weeks, I came back to work and continued my duties as a Social Service Aide I.

Rehabilitation Program

I continued to work closely with DCFS. I attended and intense Child Maltreatment training provided it was a six week intense training during the fall of 1996 Debra King was instructor, in Craighead County. This training was mandatory before becoming a Family Service Worker I. Which, I worked from September 1996- August 1998. Since then, I attended a child maltreatment workshop each year.
