Dear Arkansas Curriculum Directors,

The Illinois Holocaust Museum is offering its 2021 Online Summer Institute to educators across the nation.

Through this introductory institute, teachers will begin an investigation into the history of the Holocaust (1933-1945). During this intensive, five-day seminar, participants will become familiar with the content area, literacy-based teaching methods, and resources to teach Holocaust history to their students. The course will include primary source readings, analysis of historical documents, multimedia presentations, and presentations by experts including a Holocaust Survivor. The institute will draw interdisciplinary connections that align with state and national standards.

Educators will return to their classrooms equipped with deeper knowledge of the Holocaust and rich pedagogical resources. The program will enable them to investigate with their students the ramifications of prejudice, racism, and indifference, and the role of the individual in nurturing and protecting democratic values and human rights.
