

2022 ArPEP Admission Requirements Overview

Step 1: Meet Minimum Admission Requirements

How To:

- Secure transcripts
- Find testing information
- Secure recommendation letters
- Find background check information
- Complete the application

Bachelor's Degree Conferred

- Contact Registrar's office
- Request transcript sent to ArPEP electronically or via mail
- Must be sent electronically directly to ADE or if mailed, remain sealed

Passing Score Praxis Subject Assessment

- Must pass for the subject/grade level
- Go to www.ets.org, click Praxis and go to Arkansas page
- On the Arkansas page click Testing Requirements

Two Letters of Professional Recommendation

- Can be a former employer, or someone in the community with whom you've served in an official capacity
- Will be sent to the applicant from the writer, must be signed with contact info included in letter

Clear Criminal Background Checks

- Must clear all background checks
- Must be cleared BEFORE October 1, 2022
- Must have cleared AFTER October 1, 2021
- arkansased.gov search Background Checks

Complete Online Application

- Meet admission requirements
- Go to arkansased.gov Search ArPEP
- Under Related Links click Online Application
- Transcript, scores and background checks should be submitted electronically

Step 2: Weighted Criteria

In addition to meeting the above minimum requirements, the applicant must also score 30 points or higher on the weighted criteria.

Teaching experience must be documented by uploading resumé to application with contact information of employer available for verification.

Admission Test	
Meet approved threshold on Admission Test (Praxis CORE, GRE, MCAT, LSAT, Miller Analogies Test, GMAT, PCAT) see Chart 1 in Handbook	10
Course Grades	
B or better in the following: English Comp I, English Comp II, and College Algebra (or higher)	3 each or 10 for all
Teaching Experience	
3 or more years teaching experience in a public or accredited K-12 private school	10
1 to 3 years teaching experience in a public or accredited K-12 private school	5
Interview	
Interview, if needed. See Interview Rubric in Handbook.	5

- Upload Admission Test score report, if applicable
- Upload Resumé, if applicable
- Interview will be scheduled, if applicable
- Complete and submit application

General Timelines

Applications accepted March 1-May 27, 2022 for July admission

Test(s) should be taken prior to May 14, 2022 for scores to be back in time to upload to application.

Letters must be uploaded at time of application. Secure these prior to applying online.

Pay attention to the above dates for background checks

No applications accepted past the May 27, 2022 deadline.
