They will not, however, be given a regular lunch tray but an alternative meal that meets federal nutritional guidelines." This is in violation of A.C.A. § 6-18-715, which states "a school shall not provide a student requesting a mela or snack under this section a meal or snack that is different from the meal or snack being provided to other students in the school."
