

# Act 352: Cardiac Emergency Response Plan (CERP)

Effective 2025-2026 School Year: All Arkansas schools are required to develop and implement a Cardiac Emergency Response Plan as part of their emergency operations plan.

# What is a Cardiac Emergency Response Plan?

A CERP is a written, school-based protocol that outlines how to respond to sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) and similar life-threatening emergencies.

## Required components of the CERP:

### 1. Nationally Recognized Standards

Plan must align with guidance from organizations like the American Heart Association (AHA).

### 2. Cardiac Emergency Response Team

Designated staff trained and ready to respond to SCA events.

#### 3. AED Automated External Defibrillator) Placement

- On-site, accessible, clearly marked, and unlocked
- Must be usable within 3 minutes of a cardiac emergency.

### 4. Staff Training

- Ongoing training in CPR, AED, and first aid using nationally approved guidelines.
- Staff must be ready to assist before EMS arrives.

#### 5. Annual Drills

Practice response protocols for SCA annually.

## 6. EMS Integration

Schools must collaborate with local EMS to align their CERP with community protocols.

#### 7. Plan Dissemination & Review

- Share CERP campus wide.
- Include review and evaluation procedures.
- Revise emergency operations plan by 2026-2027 at the latest.

# Why this matters

- Sudden cardiac arrest can strike anyone students, staff, or visitors.
- A well-prepared response saves lives and improves outcomes.
