Findings:

1) Upon review of the Chartwell's invoice for the month of review, it was discovered that a telephone expense of \$50.00 was billed to the district. The child nutrition director (CND) explained that this cost was for the cell phone of the Food Service Management Company (FSMC) dining director. According to the (FSMC) contract, "the district will not reimburse for reasonable cellular telephone expenses incurred by the Director for communications related to the contract. Reasonable expenses shall not include additional services such as paging, email, or voice mail. If allowed, it must be charged as an expense by the FSMC." The local telephone expenses fall under the responsibility of the district, however cell phone expenses incurred by the FSMC are the responsibility of the FSMC.
