



# 5 THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT THE COVID-19 VACCINES



**The vaccinations are free.** Vaccines are provided locally and free of charge to all people living in the United States, regardless of their immigration or health insurance status.

**Vaccinations are easily accessible.** Arkansans can make an appointment at a community pharmacy. Vaccine clinics and events may also be available through local hospitals, local health care providers or your workplace. Call 1-800-985-6030 for assistance in finding a vaccine in your area or contact your local Arkansas Department of Health clinic.

**All Arkansans age 12 or older** are now eligible to receive the vaccine.

**Over 357 million doses of COVID-19 vaccine** have been given in the United States from December 14, 2020, through August 16, 2021. There are three vaccines currently available in the United States. The three brands are: Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson's Janssen.

**COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective.** Getting vaccinated helps prevent severe illness, hospitalization and death from COVID-19, including the Delta variant. It also helps to reduce the spread of the virus in communities.
