School districts seeking to employ educators to teach out of field (not in the field in which the educator is currently licensed) will use the Additional Licensure Plan (ALP) to meet that need. School districts may use the ALP process to address unusual emergency situations when licensed educators are asked to teach in areas/levels for which they are not licensed. School districts may not exceed the six semester limit without possible penalty.

Eligibility Guidelines: Educators must meet the following conditions:

- possess a standard Arkansas educator license,
- seek to add this area of licensure or endorsement, and
- be assigned to teach in this area rather than the one for which they are currently licensed.
- Educators licensed in the following areas: B-K, P-4, K-6, 1-6, P-8, 4-8, 4-12 are eligible to test out with the additional requirements listed below:

Required Assessments:

1. Praxis II: Elementary Education Multiple Subjects exam

#5001 Minimum subtest score required:

Reading and Language Arts 157

Mathematics 157

Social Studies 155

Science 159

(Subtests are also available separately for retaking purposes)

and

2. Pearson: Foundations of Reading exam, Minimum score 233 (Act 416 of 2017)

OR

Provide documentation of completing an approved pathway reflecting Proficiency in the Science of Reading prior to this ALP being requested. If Proficiency is not documented, prior to this ALP request, the Pearson: Foundations of Reading exam will be required to add this area.

Recommended Content Background:

- Growth, development, and learning of K-6 children,
- Factors influencing individual growth and development of K-6 children,
- Applications of developmental and curriculum theory,
- Planning and implementing curriculum for K-6 children,
- Evaluating and reporting student progress and the effectiveness of instruction for K-6 children,
- Professional and legal responsibilities for educators of K-6 children.
- Reading informational texts across the disciplines closely and critically to analyze the key ideas and details as well as craft and structure with the purpose of integrating knowledge and ideas both within and across texts.
- The science of reading, including the five essential elements of effective reading instruction (phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and text comprehension).
- Best practices in reading instruction and assessment as identified by reading research.

Employing School District Guidelines:

- The employing district will document the need to assign an educator out of field.
- The employing superintendent shall submit a waiver request and completed ALP form to the ADE Office of Educator Licensure within 30 days of the out-of-field teaching assignment, thus documenting the above statement.
- The employing school district understands that an educator working under this ALP shall make adequate yearly progress (as specified in the Rules Governing Educator Licensure) each school year that the educator is employed in the out-of-area assignment.
- The employing district understands that an educator will have no more than six consecutive semesters from the first date he/she was employed in the out-of-area assignment by any district to meet full licensure requirements for the additional licensure or endorsement being sought. A waiver request must be submitted each school year the educator is employed out-of-area.

Educator ALP Guidelines:

Educators shall make yearly progress (as specified in the Rules Governing Educator Licensure) each school year that the educator is employed in the out-of-area assignment. If the educator EITHER leaves the ALP position OR doesn't complete the requirements within six consecutive semesters, he/she will NOT be eligible for employment again under an ALP for this area of licensure.
