1) Upon reviewing verification documentation, an error was discovered. The confirming review was not completed on all eighty-five (85) applications that were pulled for Verification. In accordance with 7 CFR 245.6e(i), a confirming review is required on each application being pulled for Verification.				
2) Upon reviewing supporting documents for the December 2021 claim for reimbursement, an error was found resulting in an over claim of four hundred and twenty (420) afterschool snacks. This resulted in an overclaim of \$420. The Arkansas Department of Education, Child Nutrition Unit (ADE, CNU) may disregard an overclaim if the overclaim does not exceed \$600 per program. The disregard may be made once per Federal fiscal year for any review or activity. This overclaim is disregarded.

Findings:

- 1) Upon onsite review, it was observed that some items in storage were not dated. Foods must be labeled and dated in storage (dry storage, coolers, and freezers) to ensure adherence to food safety standards. When received, all foods should be dated to ensure proper use and safety of food supply (FIFO -first in-first out inventory procedures).
