For the week of menu review, the 9-12 lunch menu did not meet the minimum daily and weekly requirements for vegetables. 3) On the day of review, the entrée available on the grab and go line did not meet the 2 oz equivalent daily grain requirements for students in grades 9-12. 4) The planned lunch menu was not followed for the week of menu review. The substitutions made were not acceptable to meet program requirements. 5) Offer versus Serve reimbursable meal signage is not posted, including the requirement for students to select at least 1/2 cup fruit or vegetable.
