Using Explicit Instruction to Teach Vocabulary: Whether you completed a R.I.S.E. proficiency pathway or a R.I.S.E. awareness pathway, this micro-credential will guide you through the steps of using explicit instruction to teach vocabulary—to a small group of students or your whole class. Any K-12 teacher of any content can earn this micro-credential.




Providing Feedback to Promote Professional Growth: Have you been asked to coach a colleague or mentor a novice teacher? If so, this micro-credential will help you guide your colleague to thoughtful conclusions about ways to improve his or her professional practice. Potential earners include teachers, instructional coaches, or administrators who provide feedback to others on professional practices.



Supporting Positive Student Behavior Through Conversations with Students: Sometimes a challenging problem—or student—has a simple solution. This micro-credential guides educators through the process of implementing The 2 X 10 Strategy, an evidence-backed practice to improve the behavior of your most challenging student. This micro-credential is an excellent choice for first time micro-credential earners.



Creating a Trauma Sensitive Classroom: Childhood trauma has a profound effect on learning and teaching. Inspired by the book *Fostering Resilient Learners* by Kristen Souers and Pete Hall, this micro-credential encourages educators to look beyond the behavior and discover strategies to build a trauma sensitive learning environment. This micro-credential complements professional learning available from ArkansasIDEAS' *Impact Shift* online course and DESE's new *Thrive* initiative.



Educator Self-Assessment and Professional Growth: Every Arkansas educator creates a yearly professional growth plan, so every educator can earn this micro-credential. The micro-credential provides self-assessment tools related to the domains of the Danielson *Framework for Teaching* and LEADS 2.0. This micro-credential is one that you can earn before or after the school year because none of the artifacts require direct access to students.
