Upon review of 55 applications pulled for the following was discovered: Some verification letters that were sent to households were missing the non-discrimination statement and the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act statement. Five (5) applications selected for verification did not include written evidence of the frequency of payment from the household. Three (3) applications selected for verification were processed using an extended timeframe including tax returns from 2020 and a collateral contact letter from 2019. B. - As observed on the day of review during breakfast meal service, a grain-based dessert was counted and credited to preschool students.
